ST. JOSEPH'S PREP ANNOUNCES NEW VOLLEYBALL COACH

PHILADELPHIA -- St. Joseph's Prep announces the hiring of Audra Brady as the Head Volleyball Coach for the 2020 season. Brady served as an assistant coach for the past five seasons. Former head coach Scott Murphy, who stepped down after last season, has agreed to assist Audra in the transition.

"Coach Brady is well-respected by our students as well as others in the league," says Athletic Director Dennis Hart. "She brings a wealth of knowledge in the sport and is also an outstanding presence for our student-athletes. I look forward to watching as she expands her impact on the program."

Brady was a standout volleyball player at Marist College. At the end of her senior season in 2013, she was third on the all-time assists list and she was only the sixth person in school history to reach the 2,000 assists mark for her career. She also placed on the MAAC Conference All-Academic Team three times and served as a member of the school's Student Athlete Advisory Committee. A native of Allentown, PA, Brady led Allentown Central Catholic to three consecutive state title games and was named to the all-state tournament team in 2008 and first team all-conference and district setter in 2009. She and her teams were recently inducted into the Allentown Central Catholic Sports Hall of Fame.

Brady has been at the Prep since 2014 and serves as Associate Director of Online Marketing & Brand Merchandising in the Prep's Marketing Department.
